Sightseeing and food? You really can experience the best of both worlds with the Shuja Yacht at Le Royal Meridien Hotel. We recently had the chance to head down to the port (directly across from Marina Mall) where we boarded the yacht to experience a truly fantastic night out.

In terms of seating, we suggest you opt for the top deck to really take advantage of the views you'll be able to enjoy while you cruise down the coast. The mains, of course, are filled with seafood-inspired dishes, however, if you're not particularly keen about our finned friends there are plenty of land animals to choose from.
