A few more bubbles and our seafood platter later, we venture a few steps to find a display of fresh roast beef, free-range organic chicken, baked salmon en croute and lamb. Being a greedy guts we decide to take a little of each with some warm buttery vegetables.

Meats are succulent and perfectly cooked while the vegetables are warm and crisp – we find ourselves mopping up the last of the gravy with the pastry from the salmon (and hope the chef can't see us mixing everything up), it's all just so tasty!

With barely enough room for dessert, we decide to stick with ice cream and sweeties, which can be found overflowing from jars on the main display of desserts. Just as we're trying to tear ourselves away though we spot a lemon meringue pie – disaster! It went well with the ice cream and sweeties.

If you're looking for a civilised brunch without the usual overwhelming array of choice then a visit to The Café is a must. We found more time to chat as less time was spent marching around
